

The fourth meeting of the Friends of Wiscasset Public Library's Cookbook Club brought France to Lincoln County with Ina Garten's Barefoot in Paris, where members were eased into the rich flavors of French cuisine with simple recipes that provided stunning results. The evening began with diners' choice of Kir or Kir Royale, which served as lovely complements to Mussels in White Wine; crispy Cheese Straws and fluffy Cheese Puffs both sopped up the mussels' tomatoey broth beautifully, but were also incredibly delicious on their own. For the main course, attendees loaded plates with a hearty Beef Bourguignon, rich Chicken with Forty Cloves of Garlic and Moroccan Couscous, a beautiful Vegetable Tian, cheesy Cauliflower Gratin, and thick slices of fantastic buttered Brioche. There was an audible groan when diners collectively remembered there was still decadent and airy Chocolate Orange Mousse for dessert - How could we possibly eat more?! All found space in the end, and were richly rewarded for it. 
