### WHO?

- 1) Read-to-me—for ages birth up to 4 yrs.
- 2) Children's Summer Reading Club (SRC)—3 or 4 to 12 yrs.

HOW? First sign-up at the Children's Room Desk.

There you will receive your SRC kit. For the Read-tome group you will receive a record keeper for your
child

#### WHAT?

- 1) Read-to-me—Caregiver records titles of 20 books that have been read to the child. Return list to library and receive a fun gift bag including board books, growth chart & soft toy
- 2) Children's Summer Reading Club (SRC)— Participant reads or listens to 5 TO 8 books, DE-PENDING ON READING LEVEL
