Wiscasset Public Library is thankful for this addition to our town history room.


# You are our book committee!



#### Friends of the Wiscasset Public Library make a difference!

The Friends of the Wiscasset Public Library came together several years ago to raise funds for the extra projects required for our Library. Over the past two years we have worked diligently to increase our fundraising with new and innovative events. Of course, Bands for Books remains our cornerstone for fundraising. We thought you might like to know more about how the funds we raised are utilized.

During calendar year 2023 our donations to our Library totaled \$13,429.

- · We were pleased to be able to cover the costs of purchasing and install a new counter in
- the circulation area.
- · Painting of the exterior of the library uncovered some damage and we were able to cover
- · the emergency repairs required
- · Annually we make a substantial donation to the library to assist with the cost of the
- · copier, inter-library loan, cleaning and other expenses

During calendar year 2024 our donations to our Library totaled \$12,957.57. •Covered the purchase of a Cricut. This will save many hours of tedious cutting materials by •staff members

- · Paid for the painting of the circulation area
- · Annual donation to our Library for expenses
- · We continue to seek out new and innovative ways to raise money for our Library. During 2024
- we held a bake sale during the Salty Dogs Concert on the Common. We combined that with a \$5 bag sale in our used book room, Second Hand Prose.

Our Christmas Children's Sale is not a fundraising event, rather it is something we do for the our community.


