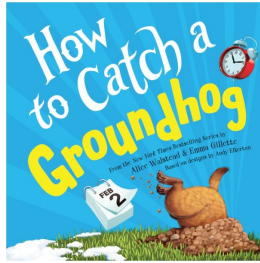

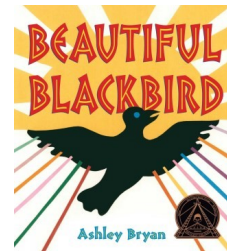
We have several historical fiction as well as picture
